- Good knowledge of the language of instruction at host university
- Your grade average

Selection procedures

After online registration is closed, the Computer Science Department of ISEC-IIAP carries out the selection procedure. The department selects Erasmus+ participants applying selection criteria's. The selection procedure takes up to two weeks through organizing interviews for the students to select. The selected students will fill-in the application form and will sign the scholarship agreement.

ERASMUS+ programme offers

- a possibility of studying abroad in UT3-PS France for a period of 6 months for MS students since the beginning of September, 2018;
- free of charge studies in the host university (UT3-PS);
- study results counted towards your ISEC degree;
