

National Academy of Sciences of Armenia



- NAS RA was founded in 1943 and is the highest state scientific self-governing organization in the country.
- It is the main R&D performer in the country and official scientific consultant to the government and other highest governing bodies of Armenia.
- NAS RA unifies scientific and research institutes,
- subsidiary services and governing body – the Presidium of the Academy.

Staff of over 3700 researchers

- 87 academicians
- 18 corresponding members
- 323 doctors of sciences
- 1006 candidates of sciences

Joint Laborotories with CNRS

On the bases of trilateral agreement between CNRS, NAS RA and SCS RA 3 joint laboratories were established in the fields of geological sciences, archaeology and physical research.





PhD and Doctoral Education

Research centers and institutes of NAS RA serve as a basis for conducting research, where 918 PhD students and 136 Doctoral students had the defense of their dissertations in over 80 fields of science from 1997-2012.






PhD and Doctoral Education

International Scientific-Educational Center of NAS RA was founded in 1997 on the basis of PhD studies operating at Academy Presidium. ISEC's main objective is to prepare scientific brainpower through Master's degree programs, PhD Studies and Doctoral Studies. ISEC is in charge of providing general educational courses and holding qualification examinations, while research and field-specific courses are carried out in appropriate research organization of NAS RA.
